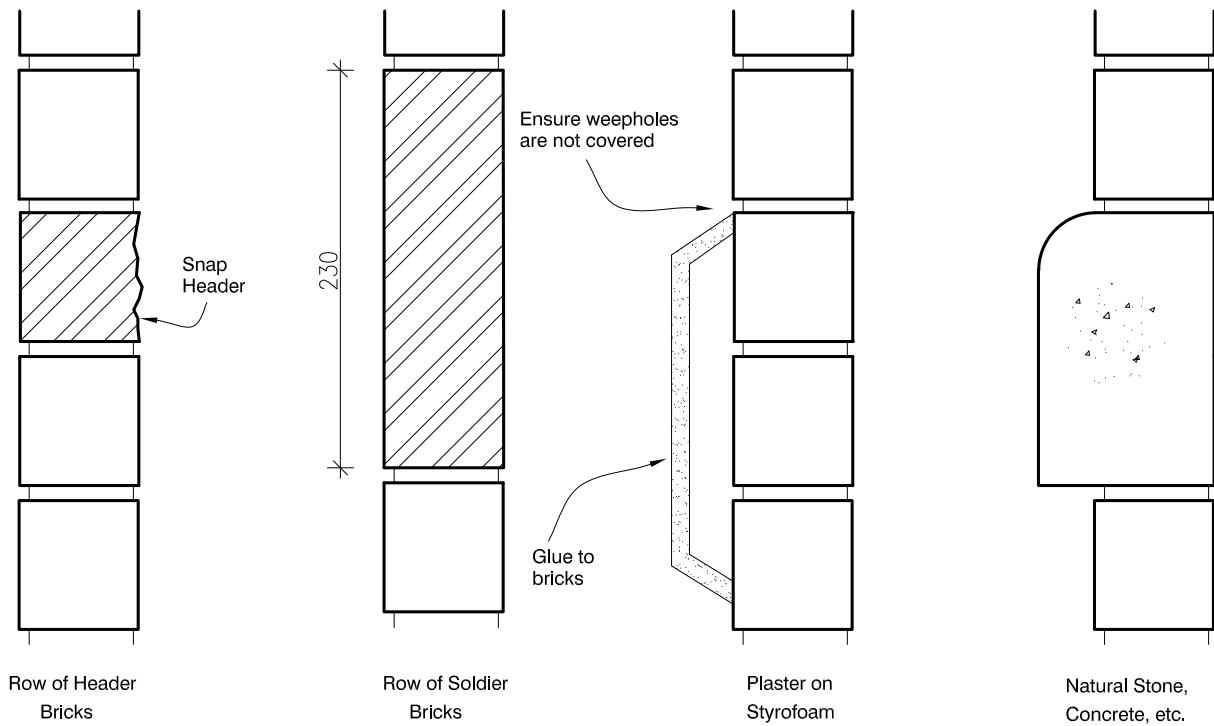


FIG. 102 BANDING



NOTES:

1. Banding is a simple but effective architectural feature that provides interest and relief to large areas of veneer.
2. May be corbelled in or out. If corbelled in, protect the frame with polythene if the cavity is less than 40mm.
3. May be achieved by laying the same brick in a different manner. eg. headers or soldiers.
4. Banding may be formed using plaster directly onto the brick veneer or by adhering styrofoam to the surface and plastering. Ensure weepholes are not covered.
5. Products such as natural stone and ceramic tiles can be used for banding.
